Due to the Coronavirus the school has been closed to the majority of children since Monday 20<sup>th</sup> April.

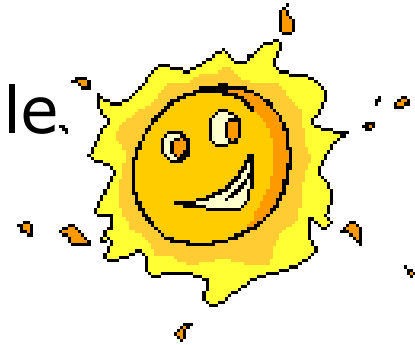
We miss the children and hope they will be allowed to return when it is safe to do so.
