

Pupil Premium Have you registered?

The school is able to access funding for your child called Pupil Premium if you receive any of the following:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseekers Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (as long as you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and you don't get more than £16,190 a year)
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Universal Credit (with annual earned income of no more than £7,400 after tax and not including any benefits you get).

Pupil Premium can help the school purchase extra computers, books, help towards the cost of staff and can support the school in offering you free school trips or discounts on some activities.

Apply today if you receive any of these benefits. It takes **5 mins** to complete. The search for Pupil Premium is done through Hertfordshire website that is used for Free School Meals applications as the two benefits are linked.

How do I register?

Registering is quick and easy; simply visits www.hertfordshire.gov.uk/freeschoolmeals and select 'Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2' then the following the instructions to apply. You will need your National Insurance Number or Home Office number to hand.
