We will be exploring 'animals including humanshealthy bodies' this term. We will be exploring the circulatory system and how to keep our bodies healthy through diet and exercise.

<u>Homework</u>

Reading remains the most important daily homework exercise. Children are expected to at least 4 times a week for around 15 minutes. This should ideally be as a combination of reading to someone, discussing the text- either the plot or characters, exploring new vocabulary and working on reading skills such as phonics, if necessary. Please sign the Reading Record, as we will monitor the children's reading records.

Times Tables is another skill the children need in all their maths learning. Therefore, they should be logging on and playing on their account at least 3 times a week for no more than 30 minutes each time.

Each week (Following SATs) there will be two pieces of homework. One will be maths related, and the other one will be project based. The children will also need to learn their lines and the songs off by heart for their performance in July.

<u>PE</u>: We will be enhancing our skills and knowledge of athletics, rounders, golf and cricket this term. PE will take place every Thursday and Friday-please ensure you have the correct kit including trainers.

<u>Geography</u>- We will be comparing our local area with Southend.

<u>History-</u> We will be learning all about the Ancient Greeks.

<u>RE</u>: We continue to learn all about the beliefs and practices of Buddhism and comparing these to Christianity.

<u>PSHE</u>: This term we will be focussing on relationships and changing me (sex education)

<u>Computing:</u> We will be understanding more about the World Wide Web and the Internet.

DT: We will be working on culture and seasonality with food. Making Scones in the second half term.

Art: We will be looking at perspective and applying this to our learning on the Ancient Greeks.

<u>French</u>: We will be learning French vocabulary based around several topics.

Music: We will be exploring music technology and learning the songs for our Year 6 performance.
