COLNEY HEATH SCHOOL PTA - TREASURER'S REPORT

OCTOBER 2020

SUMMARY

During the last financial year (1 September 2019 - 31 August 2020), the total income received by the PTA was £9863.89. Total amounts expended were £7192.89. Some income and expenditure related to prior year/future year events, however as the return to the Charity Commission is completed on a cash accounting basis, these are the figures referred to in this summary.

The brought forward bank balance for the Community and Savings accounts was £1476.04, and the combined carried forward balance as at 31 August was £2491.73. Amounts outstanding from the previous financial year at this point totalled £237.70. There were no other outstanding commitments (including pledged contributions to classes), meaning that the available funds at the start of the current financial year were £2254.03.

In addition to this is the balance in the 200 Club account, referred to separately below.
