


Reception Class Newsletter Spring Term

Curriculum

This half term will find us exploring the world with our theme, 'I wonder where in the world we will go next.' We are starting the term by taking a look around the globe at different parts of the world. We will be using the text 'Lost and Found' to learn about polar animals as well as staying safe. We will go on to read 'Emma Jane's Aeroplane' to explore different countries and also learn about Chinese New Year. The children will be learning phase 3 phonics and starting to write short sentences. In Maths we will be learning to compare amounts when counting, positional language, ordering numbers and estimating. We will move on to regrouping in the second half of the spring term. We will continue to explore the change of the seasons and follow the children's interests during their playing and learning.
