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How Will Remote Learning Work

From the questionnaire and reflects of home learning last term we have designed a remote learning approach for when a class has to self-isolated. This is a new system for all and so will be a steep learning curve for everyone, especially as it will likely have to be put into place with little notice. We won't get it right the first time and will adapt our approach accordingly.

1. Daily Live Lessons

Daily Live Lessons will be delivered at a designated time for each year group using Zoom. Invites will be sent out via the class email address and we ask that you enter the waiting room 5 minutes before the session as we cannot admit anyone once it starts.

2. Oak Academy Lessons

We will use of Oak Academy to support the learning as a daily lesson with the links being sent by each teacher.

3. Reading at home

Epic will be used to support reading alongside reading books. Class logins will be provided

4. Maths

Paper based Maths activities will be provided through ABACUS books / photocopies. This will be sent home with the child. (Yr1 to Yr6)

Other maths activities will be provided to supplement this where necessary

5. Communication and Feedback

A weekly phone call by a member of staff to talk to you and your child will provide an opportunity for feedback from the learning

Class email accounts will be used if work is to be returned before the two weeks is over.

6. Curriculum Coverage

Activities over the week covering some of the curriculum that would be delivered that week. A timetable for the class will indicate what remote learning will be provided.

7. Extra activities your child could also do

These will be provided through Lexia, Nessie and TT Rockstars (Yr3/4)

8. Paper based activities

We will endeavour to send exercise books with the children to be used as part of the remote learning approach. These books will be returned to school at the end of the two weeks. The children will also be sent home with a remote learning kit which would include pencils etc.

9. Age appropriate learning

The learning delivered will have to be aimed at an age appropriate level for that year group. In a normal classroom situation the teacher would adapt the learning for all the different needs and abilities, usually as the learning is taking place. Remotely this will not be possible. You may need to contact the class teacher for specific advice.

10. Time Expectation

For Key Stage 1, three hours of remote education will be provided.

Key stage 2 pupils will be provided with four hours

The school's provision will include both recorded or live direct teaching time, and time for pupils to complete tasks and assignments independently.

Nursery and Reception will follow a slightly different program of Remote Learning which will be shared with you by the class teachers. It will include a daily live lesson and paper based activities.

A separate document is attached to help you understand your role in supporting your child's learning at home. It is **essential** that you read this carefully as it will ensure your child gets the

full benefit from the remote learning provided. This learning cannot be delivered without your input and time.

Please keep in contact with the class teacher during this time using the class email address. They will endeavour to respond within 48 hours week days only.
