Three, six, nine....



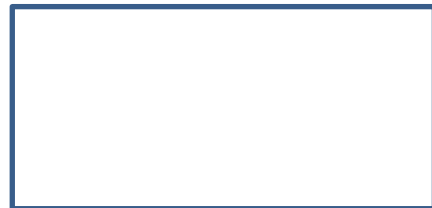
Tell me the time.

Twelve, fifteen, eighteen....



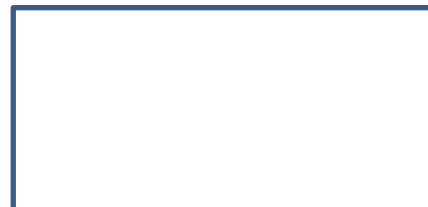
Don't keep me waiting.
