Anything else you would like us to know:

- More after school clubs for creative, not just sports life lessons e.g. baking; more 'fun' school trips educational but also 'fun' in a kids eye; get the kids out of the village, always walking around the village on trips.
- It would be a good idea to have a more wider range of after school activities. If your child does not like football or netball they do not have anything else to do.
- Year 6 children have a number of group chats on Messenger. As X uses my AppleID login I can see all the messages. I feel all the children could do with a reminder of social media etiquette and the pit falls of social media before someone gets carried away and makes a mistake.
- I am really pleased with how much the school and teachers have improved this year. Lovely to see the changes.
- Lunches to be bigger. My son says he hasn't had much food that day.
- We are very grateful for how hard working all the teachers, TAs and staff are, there is a lot of pressure in the public sector currently especially teaching. Thank you very much.
- I think it may be nice to have a school newsletter. A brief run down of what has been happening in each year group ...cross country, trips etc. Also perhaps a monthly review of what the classes are up to. I appreciate there is already a lot of work on your plates but just a thought.
- I believe that communication needs to be better especially for children with additional needs. I feel this has been good during Infants but not so much in juniors as all children are not the same so cannot reach the same level of independence.
- The violin is amazing. I feel very heard as a parent. The school is extremely supportive and responds quickly to any questions or worries.
- Fabulous leadership, wonderful staff and we are lucky to be part of an excellent school with high standards and a nurturing approach.
- Very happy with school. X and Y are very happy in Year 1 and Reception.
- Thank you very much. My kids are enjoying the school. Great teachers, great staff and happy students. Sorry about my handwriting.
- More activities for Year 2 in the front playground ie a climbing frame.
- We would appreciate more (optional?) home learning, TT Rockstars, reading and spelling gets a bit repetitive. We loved last year's hwk one piece per week, usually Maths/Literacy.
- I would like children to get regular homework set maybe once a week. That gives parents more ideas what children are learning plus prepares them for secondary school (where they are given lots of homework).
