


Colney Heath School ~ GEOGRAPHY Summer term

Weather / seasons – Yr1		Beach	an area of sand or <u>stones</u> beside the sea
		Port / harbour	an area of the sea at the <u>coast</u> which is <u>partly enclosed</u> by land or strong walls, so that <u>boats</u> can be left there safely
		coast	an area of land that is <u>next</u> to the sea
By the end of our project we will know that:		Cliff	a high area of land with a very steep side, <u>especially</u> one <u>next</u> to the sea
Location: Know where Colney Heath is on a map of UK Know where seaside village is on a map of UK – Leigh-On-Sea		shop	a building or part of a building where things are <u>sold</u> .
Physical Features: Identify physical features of Colney Heath Village – Common, stream, woodland, farm land		sea	the <u>salty</u> water that covers about <u>three-quarters</u> of the Earth's surface
Identify physical features of Seaside Town – River, sea, hills, coast, cliffs, beach		river	a large amount of fresh water flowing continuously in a long line across the land
Human Features: Identify human features of Colney Heath Village – road, school. Shops, houses, coal posts, church, village hall, park, farm		town	a place with many <u>streets</u> and buildings, where people <u>live</u> and work
Identify human features of Seaside Town – road, school, shops, houses, harbour, church, park,		village	a group of houses, <u>together</u> with other buildings such as a <u>church</u> and a <u>school</u> , in a country area
		farm	an area of land, together with the buildings on it, that is used for growing <u>crops</u> or <u>raising</u> animals
		common	an area of <u>grassy</u> land, usually in or near a <u>village</u> or small <u>town</u> , where the public is <u>allowed</u> to go
		park	a public area of land with grass and trees
