

		<div>The 99 Names of Allah</div> 	Key Prayer: Frst Surah in the Qu'ran	The Surah is the first chapter of the Quran . Its seven verses are a prayer for the guidance, lordship and mercy of God. This chapter has an essential role in Islamic prayer.
Ultimate Questions			Worship in a mosque	Worshippers face a wall when they pray so that they are praying towards the holy city of Islam. At the mosque , men and women pray in separate rooms performing the series of movements in a sequence. This involves bowing and kneeling as well as prostration and reciting praises to God.

Community	Belonging to a community that shares the same religious ideas		Worship in church	Involves praising God in music and speech, readings from scripture, prayers of various sorts, a sermon, and various holy ceremonies
Faith	Complete trust or confidence in someone or something		Key Prayer: The Lord's Prayer	It is recited in most Christian services and is a prayer which Jesus used to help teach his followers to pray . It is the most important Christian prayer
Religious Belief	Religious belief means the belief in a religion's central articles of faith, for example, within Christianity that Jesus is the Son of God.		Easter	Most important and oldest festival of the Christian Church, celebrating the resurrection of Christ.
Fife Pillars of Islam	The declaration of faith, prayer, alms-giving, fasting and pilgrimage – constitute the basic norms of Islamic practice.		Eucharist	Commemorating the Last Supper.
Praying	Address a prayer to God or another deity.		Lent	Lent is a season of reflection and preparation.
Religious leadership	Someone who is recognised by a religious body as having some authority within that body. The leader of a religious order. Christianity: Vicar Islam: Imam	Holy Week	Observed with special solemnity as a time of devotion to the Passion of Jesus Christ.

99 names of Allah	Allah has many different descriptions and it is hard to represent him in a few words, so the Qur'an teaches that Allah has 99 names. Each of the 99 names relates to a particular attribute of Allah, making him easier to understand and relate to.
Trinity	The traditional Christian doctrine of the Trinity is commonly expressed as the statement that the one God exists as or in three equally divine "persons", the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.
World beginning Christianity Islam	Christians who take the Bible literally believe the world was created by God in seven days. Some Muslims around the world believe "humans and other living things have evolved over time," yet some others believe they have "always existed in present form."
