				<p>Surreal</p> <p>Another reality different from our own.</p>	
				<p>The Elements of Art</p> <p>The seven elements of art are line, shape, space, tone, form, texture, and colour. These elements are the building blocks, or ingredients, of art.</p>	
				<p>Shape</p> <p>The area in 2D space defined by edges.</p>	
				<p>Line</p> <p>A mark that goes between two points taking any form along the way.</p>	
				<p>Tone</p> <p>The use of light and dark, shade and highlight.</p>	
				<p>Portrait</p> <p>A painting, drawing, photograph, or engraving of a person, especially one depicting only the face or head and shoulders.</p>	
				<p>Self Portrait</p> <p>A portrait that an artist produces of himself or herself.</p>	
				<p>Proportion</p> <p>Refers to the relative size of parts of a whole.</p>	
				<p>Medium</p> <p>The materials that are used to create a work of art.</p>

Frida Kahlo (1907-1954)	A Mexican painter known for her many portraits, self-portraits, and works inspired by the nature and artefacts of Mexico.
