Topics for this term!

English - This term we will be looking at creating graphic novels, poetry, some persuasive speeches, non-fiction writing explaining crazy contraptions and some short story writing.

Maths - This term we will be working on our place value up to 10,000 and we will be looking at addition, subtraction, multiplication and division of numbers. Towards the end of the term we will start working on measurements and statistics.

Science - This term we will be looking at changing sound and living things.

History - In the first half term we are going to study Ancient Egyptians, including their language, traditions and culture.

Geography - In the second half term we will be looking at rivers, how they form and how they can help us.

Art - In the first half term we will be working on collage, and linking it to our history topic.

D&T - In the second half term we will be looking at shell structures by creating 3-dimensional shapes.

Music - We will be working on our glockenspiel playing and will be learning new songs, such as: MamaMia!

RE - We will be focusing on Christianity and what Christians believe are the teachings of Jesus.

PE - This term we will be looking at possession and invasion in sports, as well as mindfulness, handball and problem solving.
